

Travel to Monterey, California

Monterey is situated 60 miles south of San Jose International Airport, 120 miles south of downtown San Francisco and 340 miles north of Los Angeles. The Monterey Peninsula Airport is located just four miles from the Portola Plaza. Travel time is ten minutes. Taxi service is approximately \$12 each way.

Air Transportation

Many flights are also available into San Francisco, San Jose and Phoenix, Arizona. The Phoenix flights have connecting service to Monterey.

Non-stop flights to San Francisco are available at least once per day from the following cities: Newark, Cleveland, Houston (via Continental); Detroit, Minneapolis, Memphis (via Northwest); Atlanta, Salt Lake City, JFK (New York) (via Delta); Newark, Chicago, Washington/Dulles, Denver, JFK (New York) (via United); Phoenix, Las Vegas (via US Airways); Chicago, Dallas, New York, Newark (via American).

Non-stop flights to San Jose are available at least once per day from the following cities: Newark, Houston (via Continental); Minneapolis (via Northwest); Atlanta, Salt Lake City, JFK (New York) (via Delta); Chicago, Dallas (via American).

Ground Transportation (Bus Service)

Monterey Airbus offers bus service from San Jose and San Francisco Airports to Monterey. Passengers are picked up at the arrival level of the airport. Buses run 11 times per day (every 90 minutes) and a reservation is strongly recommended and can be made by calling **(831) 373-7777**. Passengers will be allowed on the bus without a reservation if space permits. The cost from San Francisco to Monterey is \$40 per person and buses run from 6:45 am to 10:00 pm. The cost from San Jose to Monterey is \$30 per person and buses run from 7:30 am to 10:45 pm.

Municipal Parking

Affordable municipal parking is available near the hotel in Monterey.
